



MINISTRY DESCRIPTION: FRONTLINE VOCAL TEAMS

Definition:

Frontline Vocals Teams are made up of Worship Choir members who lead worship, with microphone, on a rotating basis with the Worship Leader. Notice, they are not called the “Praise or Worship Team.” Everyone on stage, the choir, the band, and the frontline vocals all combine to form the Worship Team.

Purpose:

- Give support to the Worship Leader and Worship Choir vocally
- Vocally strengthens the sound of our combined worship
- Better contact with congregation: eye contact, etc.
- Expresses worship by conveying what God has done in the worshipper’s heart
- Brings out harmonies with the choir and congregation
- Helps discover and develop talent of singers

Responsibilities:

- Heart of worship and love for the Lord
- Have a teachable spirit
- Consistent, dedicated member of Worship Choir and FBC Islands
- Ability to listen, blend and stay consistently on pitch with other singers
- Expected to attend regularly scheduled choir rehearsals
- Expected to sing in both the 9:00 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. services
- Expected to memorize their vocal part so they can bring out harmonies on mic
- Dress code as assigned by Worship Pastor

Process:

- Member of Worship Choir and FBC Islands for at least 6 months
- Interview/audition with Worship Pastor
- Singer placed on rotation schedule
- Singer practices and personally prepares music at home with PCO and website
- Singer attends regular choir rehearsals with music prepared
- Possible vocal workshops/retreats during the year
