ChartBuilder allows you to access dynamic chord charts, transpose keys, and follow live arrangements during rehearsals and services.

1. What is ChartBuilder?

ChartBuilder is a digital app for worship teams that allows you to:

- View dynamic chord charts for every song in your setlist.
- Transpose charts into any key instantly.
- Adjust the capo setting for guitarists.
- Follow real-time arrangements during services.

It's available on iOS and Android.

2. Downloading & Logging In

1. Download **ChartBuilder** from the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android).
2. Log in with the credentials provided by [Your Name/Administrator].
 - You'll need an active MultiTracks subscription linked to your church account to access songs.

3. Navigating the App

- **Setlists:** View your assigned setlists under the **Setlists** tab.
- **Songs:** Tap a song to open its chord chart.
- **Sections:** Use the app's navigation to jump between song sections (e.g., Verse, Chorus, Bridge).
- **Transposition:**
 - Use the key dropdown menu to change keys.
 - Guitarists: Adjust the capo setting to match your preferences.

4. Practice with ChartBuilder

- **Loop Sections:** Use the loop function to repeat tricky parts during practice.
- **Adjust Tempo/Arrangement:** Sync charts with the arrangement being used in rehearsal.
- **Offline Access:** Download setlists beforehand so you can view charts offline.

5. Using ChartBuilder Live

During rehearsals and services:

- Follow the live arrangement provided by the worship leader.
- Pay attention to dynamic changes (e.g., key changes, tempo adjustments).

6. Why Switch to ChartBuilder?

- **Real-Time Adjustments:** Update charts on the fly if arrangements change.
- **Unified Team Experience:** Everyone stays on the same page—literally!
- **Greater Flexibility:** Transpose and customize charts to fit your instrument.

7. Helpful Tips for Success

- **Enable Notifications:** Stay updated when setlists or charts are modified.
- **Practice First:** Familiarize yourself with the app at home before rehearsals.
